**Weather Report - Northern Region**

The North Ops region will be under the influence of high pressure through Wednesday. Winds will be light in most areas, and overnight RH recovery will be better tonight and Wednesday night than in recent days. A low pressure trough will approach the region Thursday and increase southwesterly winds throughout the region, but with higher humidity as well. A closed low pressure area will develop over the North Ops area Thursday night as the trough moves southward, and quickly deepen as it moves to Central CA early Friday. This will cause strong and gusty northerly winds early Friday from the west slopes of the Sierra to the eastern portion of the Mid Coast PSA. Gusts in wind-prone areas will be 40-50 mph. Gusty northerly and northeasterly winds will continue Friday, and strong northeasterly winds Friday night and Saturday will reach the eastern Bay Area. Late Saturday the pressure gradient will relax and only light to locally moderate northeasterly winds are expected Saturday night.

**Weather Report - Southern Region**

**\*\*\*WIDESPREAD STRONG SANTA ANA WINDS OVER SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA THROUGH WEDNESDAY \*\*\***

**\*\*\*WELL ABOVE NORMAL TEMPERATURES AND VERY DRY ACROSS THE REGION THROUGH WEDNESDAY \*\*\***

A strong ridge of high pressure over California will bring well above normal temperatures and very low humidity to the region through Wednesday. Temperatures will be 10 to 20 degrees above normal and minimum humidity will be in the single digits and teens across the region through Wednesday. There will be widespread strong and gusty north to east winds over Southern California this morning. Winds will be 20 to 40 mph with much higher gusts over the mountains and below the canyons and passes of Southern California this morning. Winds will start to decrease over Southern California this afternoon and become light by Wednesday night. The ridge of high pressure will weaken as a Pacific trough drops down the West Coast bringing a cooling trend and an increase in humidity Thursday and Friday. Another strong ridge of high pressure will build north into California from Mexico bringing a warming trend and lower humidity to the region Saturday through early next week.

**Strong Santa Ana conditions exist, resulting in wind driven fire with spotting one-half mile ahead of the fire front. Isolated head fire runs anticipated. 30-50 ft. flame lengths are common. Rate of spread was observed at up to 2-miles per hour. ICP was established at Malibu City Hall. Mandatory evacuations were implemented in the following areas: Monte Nido, Malibu Colony, Malibu Rd., Sweetwater Cyn., Carbon Cyn., Carbon Mesa, Rambla Pacifica, Big Rock, Topanga Cyn., Powder Ranch Rd. and Monte Vista Dr. Voluntary evacuations were implemented for the following areas: Corral Cyn., Sunset Mesa, Topanga Cyn., and Old Topanga Cyn. The following road closures are in effect: PCH between Topanga Cyn. and Kanan-Dume Rd.; Malibu Cyn. between PCH and Piuma Rd.
